Miltiades B. Hatzopoulos was born in Athens in 1944. He is a member of the Academy of Athens, of the Institut de France (Académie des Inscriptions et Belles Lettres) and a corresponding fellow of the British Academy. He took his Bachelor's degree, his Ph.D and his Habilitation from the Sorbonne (1971-1988). He has worked as a high school teacher of French, Latin and Greek in France (1967-1970), as editor and editor-in-chief at Ekdotike Athenon in Greece (1971-1979) and as a Greek History professor at the University of Paris X, Nanterre (1989-1991). From 1979 he was a researcher at the Research Centre for Greek and Roman Antiquity (K.E.R.A), which he directed from 1992 to 2010. He has written and edited alone or in collaboration 22 monographs and corpora of inscriptions, as well as more than 150 shorter studies on ancient Macedonia, Epirus, Thrace and Cyprus.
